This workshop aims to present the role and structure of practice-based training as part of the overall programme for intercultural mediators of the Reggio Emilia Local Health Authority (AUSL RE). This type of training is problem-based and grounded on reflective observation and guided discussion to develop professional skills and knowledge, and improve performance. The volunteer-trainees will learn how to introduce internship and placement in practice-based training (duration, setting, roles, and tasks); and how to conduct assessment of training activities and learning outcomes (methods and tools). This workshop will aslo offer the opportunity to exchange experiences between volunteer-trainees in the field of interpreting and intercultural mediation in healthcare.
